

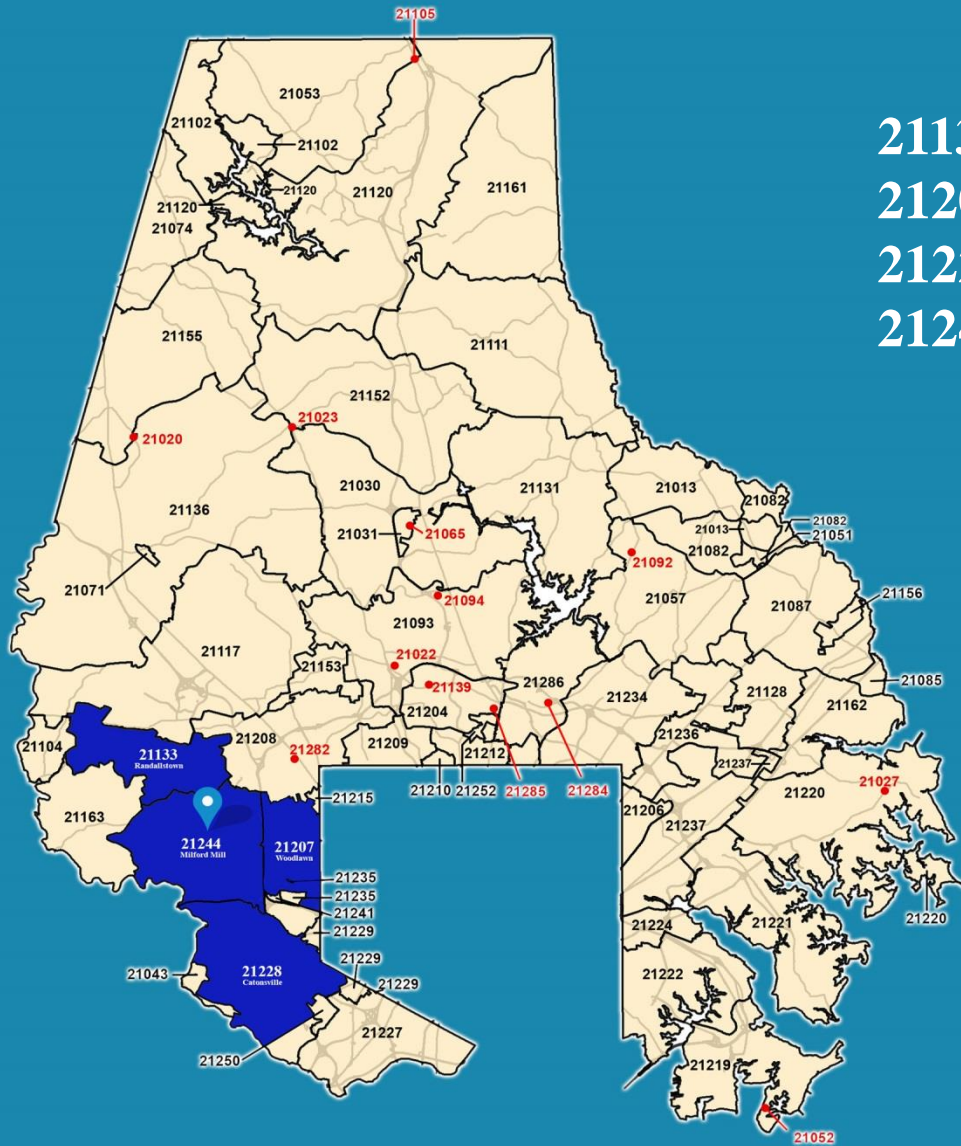

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Community Needs Assessment (CNA)

In 2016 Liberty Community Development Corporation Inc. conducted a community needs assessment (CNA) of it's PCA with the support of the Robert Woods Johnson Foundation (County Health Rankings and Roadmaps) and data provided by:

- Baltimore County Health Department
- Baltimore County Police Department
- Department of Justice
- Federal Bureau of Investigation Uniform Crime Data
- LifeBridge Health
- Maryland Department of Health and Mental Hygiene
- Maryland Department of Labor, Licensing and Regulations
- U.S. Census Bureau



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CNA Major Findings

- ✓ Part 1 violent crime rates for PCA are considerably higher than part 1 violent crime rates at the county, state and national levels.
- ✓ Milford Mill, Randallstown and Woodlawn sexually transmitted infections such as chlamydia and gonorrhea, incidence rates are significantly higher than county, state and national incidence rates. The younger the age the higher the rate of infection.
- ✓ Milford Mill, Randallstown and Woodlawn accounts for approximately 14% of Baltimore County's population but 26.8% and 26.4% of Baltimore County's HIV and AIDS diagnosis respectively for the adult and adolescent population.

CNA Major Findings

- ✓ Milford Mill and Woodlawn have lower levels of educational attainment compared to Randallstown and Catonsville.
- ✓ Unemployment rates for the PCA were trending upward, while unemployment rates at the county, state and national levels were trending downward.
- ✓ Milford Mill has a lower life expectancy and median household income below county and state levels. It also has a lower proportion of husband-wife households, low rates of home ownership and high rates of rental occupancy.
- ✓ PCA lacks adequate assets to provide a comprehensive approach to the major findings outlined in the CNA.



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
